Patron's Research Grant Sponsored by Physio Control (\$15,000)

The generous support of Physio Control through the provision of a sponsorship of \$15,000 enables the Foundation to offer this research grant annually.

In 2010 the grant was awarded to the QAS South West Region entrant, Oakey Officer-in-Charge Brad Setch.

Brad's project aims to reduce the time spent on the management of road crash patients at the scene.

He plans to conduct a series of relocation and controlled-roll techniques on vehicles with mannequins to recreate several extrication scenarios, and have the techniques and conduct agreed to by QAS paramedics as the best practice approach for those types of incidents.

As well as improving patient care, Brad's project is breaking new ground in the road crash rescue field.
