GUIDE TO APPLICATION FOR DR PETER STEPHENSON OVERSEAS STUDY GRANT

The KJ McPherson Education and Research Foundation annually seeks applications from uniformed QAS personnel for a Dr Peter Stephenson Overseas Study Grant under the Foundation's charter. A grant is offered to the value of \$5,000 for the successful applicant's submission for an overseas educational opportunity judged to be the most outstanding amongst the submissions received. You are invited to submit a case study to become eligible for a grant. Applications are made in accordance with the following format.

CASE:	A brief title for the clinical conference or educational activity and include the aims and objectives.
DESCRIPTION of CONFERENCE/ACTIVITY:	A brief description of the conference or activity attending.
WHY PARTICIPATION WILL BENEFIT QAS:	Provide a brief statement of 1 to 2 sentences on how your participation in this conference or activity will benefit QAS.
HOW THE APPLICANT INTENDS TO RE-INVEST THE LEARNING / DEVELOPMENT REQUIRED INTO PATIENT CARE OR AMULANCE OPERATIONS:	Provide a brief statement of 1 to 2 sentences on how you intend to apply the learning or activity.
OUTCOMES:	Describe the expected outcomes.
SCOPE/SAMPLE:	A description of the boundaries of the project i.e. what is included and if relevant what is not. If it is a research project -How will the sample be selected?
RESOURCES/BUDGET:	What human and material resources e.g. personnel, equipment, travel, postage etc are required? What are the estimated costs? Resource gaps should be identified.

Please note all applications require the Assistant Commissioner's endorsement.
