BUNDABERG LAC STATE OPERATIONS GRANT

CURRENTLY SPONSORED BY BUNDABERG LAC

In 2017 a new grant was offered specifically for uniformed state operations officers for overseas study. This grant has been established by request of the Bundaberg Local Ambulance Committee for providing opportunities for professional development for uniformed officers in QAS State Operations Centres.

In support of the Foundation Bundaberg Local Ambulance Committee (LAC) has provided a grant of \$5,000 for the professional development of Ambulance Officers to be awarded yearly over the next three years. The grant provides financial assistance to attend an overseas clinical conference such as the Navigator Conference (<https://www.emergencydispatch.org/Conference>) or similar educational activity.

The conference or activity must be relevant to emergency dispatch, resource deployment or ambulance operations, and recipients must be able to demonstrate that their attendance will help them to meet a career development objective and contribute to the knowledge base of the Queensland Ambulance Service.

This grant will be made to any uniformed state operations officer for a significant contribution to the promotion or development of clinical or operational practice in ambulance services.

The grant will provide financial assistance for conference registration, fares and accommodation to attend a conference or similar activity in the pre-hospital care or emergency medicine fields.

NOTE

- The LASN Manager's signature of approval is required on an application.
- This grant may be subject to ministerial approval for overseas travel.
- The Foundation expects receipt of a copy of the international travel report required by the Department of Health. The report will also be published on the departmental intranet (QAS Portal) for access by all QAS personnel.
- The recipient is required to give a report of their educational experience at the annual KJM Patron's Day Clinical Symposium.
