

Ambulance services across Queensland are coordinated through 15 Local Ambulance Service Networks (LASNs), based geographically around Queensland Hospital and Health Services. Due to the remote nature of ambulance stations in rural parts of Queensland, stations which can support Graduates are indicated in **bold**.
