



DEVELOPMENT GRANTS

UNITED VOICE STUDENT OF THE YEAR GRANT

CURRENTLY SPONSORED BY UNITED VOICE

This award is offered to encourage students to strive for excellence throughout their course.

A grant of \$2,000 applies with \$1 000 to be provided to assist the student to further studies, competencies, or ambulance knowledge in their subsequent 12 months of full-time service and a further \$1 000 donated to the Foundation base funds.

The grant recipient is selected from nominations made by educators from Queensland Ambulance Service Education Centre (QASEC), Regional Staff Development officers and the student's immediate supervisors.

The selection is made through a competitive assessment process by a panel chaired by the Education and Development Manager. All QAS officers who have graduated from their education program in the twelve months preceding the grant are eligible.

The winner of this grant will be a uniformed QAS student from a QAS educational program who has completed their program in the period from 1 October of the previous year to 1 October in the current year, having demonstrated consistent outstanding performance throughout their studies.

Applicants must be nominated by QASEC or the Regional Manager Staff Development through QASEC.

Eligible candidates are those paramedics who have graduated from a Queensland university in the immediate recent 12-month period and has achieved employment as a paramedic with Queensland Ambulance Service.
